

CNG Incentive Policy for Gibson County Utility District

RESPONSIBLE FOR ADMINISTERING POLICY:

BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE:

The Utility is subject to various city, county, state, federal or other governmental agency requirements and has no discretion to provide service in a manner which would violate such regulations or requirements.

OMISSIONS:

In the absence of specific rules or policies, the disposition of situations involving service shall be made by the Governing Board in accordance with its usual and customary practices.

POLICY STATEMENT:

In the best interest of promoting energy supplies of natural gas as an alternative to imported crude and petroleum products, Gibson County Utility District has built a CNG Filling Station for public use. The Gibson County Energy Complex is also an economic development incentive to promote the use of abundant, cleaner -burning, domestically produced natural gas by our customers and to promote the development of infrastructure for CNG vehicles.

GCUD establishes this policy stating the criteria for GCUD to establish CNG incentives for customers.

1. GCUD will evaluate each customer's needs on a case by case basis.
2. The incentive will be based on the incremental cost for the CNG fueling component on a vehicle.

3. The Customer will be charged a per gallon price for the CNG fueling to pay back GCUD for the incentive paid at the time of the vehicle purchase.
4. GCUD Management will establish the per GGE cost based on the incentive cost, projected annual mileage, and other factors to determine the best solution to promote CNG for fleet use.
